


Invitation

During the 10th *AkoPoznan Accordion Days 2021*, organised by the Department of Accordion and Contemporary Music Interpretation, we are planning a conference, tango workshops, a student panel, a master class and an intercollegiate accordion concert.

The leading topic of the conference will be the *History of Tango. In the circle of Astor Piazzolla on the centenary of the composer's birth*. Conference participants will explore the history of tango in the context of the phenomenon of Astor Piazzolla's work, exploring the origins of the genre and pointing out the consequences of the spread of tango to other continents in light of the history of the accordion and bandoneon. We will also have the opportunity to get acquainted with the works of Astor's predecessors, less known in Europe, including Polish composers and contemporary artists inspired by Piazzolla's work.
