Finally, the documentation to be submitted by the Candidate to the Doctoral School in electronic version should include 13 .pdf files (symphonic and opera conductors – 14 files) with the names indicated below. An additional document may be a certificate confirming the knowledge of the relevant language, if the regulations require its submission.

The documents should be filled on the computer, printed out, and then signed by hand before scanning (applies to 1, 2, 4-9, 11, 12, and 13 below).

Acceptable formats are .pdf, .jpg, .tif, .png. The maximum attachment size is 20MB.

- **1. [APPLICATION]** A signed application for admission to the Doctoral School, according to the template downloadable from the Academy's website (File signed IRK identifier application).
- **2.** [PERSONAL DATA FORM] A personal data form, according to the template downloadable from the Academy's website (File signed IRK identifier personal data form).
- **3. [DIPLOMA]** A certified copy of a higher education diploma that confirms that the Candidate boasts a professional degree or other diploma referred to in Article 326(2) or 327(2) of the Law in conjunction with Article 186(1)(1) of the Law; original diploma should be available for request. In the case of diplomas obtained abroad, the diploma must be submitted together with its translation into Polish. The translation should be made by a Polish sworn translator. The diploma should be accompanied by a written opinion issued by the National Agency for Academic Exchange certifying that the document entitles the student to open a doctoral program in Poland. - **4. [LIST OF ACHIEVEMENTS]** A list of the Candidate's artistic and academic achievements. The documentation should be prepared in the form of a table (downloadable from the Academy's website).
