on the recruitment of foreign students for the academic year 2014/2015

GENERAL INFORMATION

The I.J. Paderewski Academy of Music is located in Poznań.

The Academy offers education at five Faculties:

Faculty of Composition, Conducting, Theory of Music and Eurhythmics

Faculty of Instruments

Faculty of Bowed Instruments, Harp, Guitar and Violin-Making

Faculty of Vocal Performance and Acting

Faculty of Choir Conducting, Music Education and Church Music

The Academy offers two-cycle studies **with the instruction in Polish language**:

1. first-cycle studies (three-year BA studies),
2. second-cycle studies (two-year MA studies),
3. third-cycle studies (Instrumental doctoral studies).

The Academy offers rooms for rent at Dom Studenta (Student Dormitory). Information about costs will be available at the beginning of the academic year

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

First-cycle and second-cycle studies

- **First cycle-studies** –secondary school certificate equivalent to Polish secondary school certificate translated also into Polish (details on equivalents can be found at www.buwiwm.edu.pl),
Second-cycle studies – diploma of BA studies (first-cycle studies) or MA studies (second-cycle studies), or five-year MA studies equivalent to Polish diploma, translated also into Polish
- Confirmation of the knowledge of Polish language in one of the following forms:
 - certificate confirming the knowledge of Polish issued by the State Commission for the Certification of Proficiency in Polish as a Foreign Language,
 - certificate of completing one-year preparatory course for studying in Polish in one of the institutions appointed by the minister in charge of the higher education,
 - confirmation of the accepting institution that their preparation and the level of Polish is sufficient for studying in Polish.
- printed application form – it is created for each candidate individually after filling in an electronic form;
- copy of a passport photo page,
- two photographs, size 37x52 mm (light background, no cap) signed on the reverse,
- one colour photograph in digital format - 300 dpi resolution (300 dots per inch) in one of the following formats: jpg, tif, bmp; real print size 20 x 25 mm (requirements like with ID photos: left half-profile, visible ear without jewellery, no cap, no tinted glasses)
