Citizens of the UE/ EFTA countries can undertake first-cycle and second-cycle studies and the regulations are the same as for the Polish citizens, they need to have finances to cover their expenses during their studies.

To study without a tuition fee, students of EU/EFTA countries need to show B1 certificate proving the knowledge of Polish or complete a one-year preparatory course to study in Polish at the institutions designated by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education. The recruitment requirements are the same as for the Polish citizens. Information on how to receive B1 certificate of Polish can be found at www.buwiwm.edu.pl. Candidates for third-cycle studies are required to know Polish at C2 level.

First-cycle, second-cycle and third-cycle studies

• copy of the proof of payment – 150 Polish zloty

EXTRA INFORMATION FOR CITIZENS FROM OUTSIDE EU/EFTA

The citizens of countries from outside **UE/EFTA** must pay the tuition. The tuition is not required from holders of a valid Polish Card (Karta Polaka). For persons listed in art..43, pts. 2.1), 2), 3), 5), 6), 6a) of Higher Education Act of 27 July 2005 the regulations are the same as for Polish citizens. Candidates need to show B1 certificate certifying their knowledge of Polish or complete a one-year preparatory course to study in Polish at the institutions designated by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education. Admission is granted on the basis of a passed entrance exam (exam programme is described below). Candidates for third-cycle studies are required to know Polish at C2 level.

Tuition fees:

First-cycle and second-cycle studies

- Fee: 6700 EUR for the first year of study (exception: conducting 20.200 EUR), paid by 15 October 2014.
- 6500 EUR for the next year of study II, III year of first-cycle and II year of second-cycle studies (exception: conducting 20.000 EUR).

Third-cycle studies

- Fee: 3200 EUR for the first year of study, paid by 15 October 2014.
- 3000 EUR for the next year of study (II, III year)
